### ***New Staff Leadership Named for Statewide Education Association***

The PA Association of School Business Officials (PASBO) has named new staff leadership effective July 1, 2019, as result of the retirement of current Executive Director Jay Himes. The final appointments were unanimously approved by the PASBO Board of Directors yesterday.

Dr. Wayne K. McCullough will assume the position of executive director while Hannah Barrick, JD, will become assistant executive director. They currently serve in the positions of director of leadership and development and director of advocacy, respectively.

PASBO President Robert E. Saul, PCSBA, said “the outstanding qualifications and expertise of our current staff made a broader search unnecessary. We have two fabulous individuals that can continue our organizational success.”

McCullough spent 28 years with Southern York County School District in finance and operations. He is a faculty member for the School Business Leadership master’s program at Wilkes University and was instrumental in developing a new undergraduate program with an emphasis in school business management at Wilkes. McCullough is a graduate of Elizabethtown College, and obtained his advanced degrees at the University of Phoenix.

Barrick has been involved in government relations for 6 years and is responsible for PASBO’s advocacy efforts in Harrisburg. She is recognized for her recent efforts on behalf of public schools in the development of the new Basic Education and Special Education funding formulas and working with the PlanCon Advisory Committee to reestablish a program to assist schools with building construction and maintenance. She is a graduate of Hamilton College and obtained her law degree from Quinnipiac University School of Law.
